Enrichment & Curriculum

SCALED Learning™, the Y's holistic before and after-school curriculum, presents kids with new challenges as they reach each stage of their development. SCALED Learning™ helps kids grow in the classroom and out in the world through engaging in STEM, hands-on arts, literacy, career-connected learning, diversity and global education, social development, and fun! Kids who participate in the Y's before and after school programs expand the school day through active play with classmates and curriculum that augments what they're learning in school. Discovering the world is fun and safe with the experts on helping kids grow and learn in spirit, mind, and body.

SCALED LEARNING™

STEM (s): STEM projects engage kids in science, technology, engineering or math to practice academic skills, critically think and promote investigation, inquiry, and discovery.

Career-Connected Learning (C): Kids explore career paths through integrated lesson plans and get to know real professionals in industries like engineering, medicine, business, and education though classroom visits.

Arts (A): Kids engage in hands-on art projects which grow in complexity as they get older. They will explore a variety of art techniques and media as they discover ways to creatively express themselves.

Literacy (L): Literacy activities engage kids in reading aloud and discussion, creative writing, Reader's Theater, and word games to practice academic skills and promote expression.

Education (E): YMCA programs help students build confidence to become active learners both in and out of the classroom. From homework help to spellings bees and more, the Y helps kids love learning.

Diversity & Global Learning (D): Kids become good global citizens through cultural events and projects which explore diverse perspectives, ideas, beliefs. and customs.

The options below include the after school program from the first day of school to the last day of school, on school days only.

Program Option Monthly Fee PM Program \$469

The PM program operates from school dismissal until 6:00pm. Includes free extended care until 6:00pm. Monthly fees are reduced during some shorter months; when enrolling online, please review the monthly payment plan. Full-Day Care and Day Camps are available during school breaks and require a separate registration and enrollment. Full-Day Care and Day Camps may be held off-site.

With the exception of the AM only option, the options below cover program during the school year, from the first day of school until the last day of school and includes student-free days, early dismissal & minimum days and full-day day camps during the fall, winter and spring school breaks.

The AM program operates from 7:00am* until the start of school. The PM program operates from school dismissal until 6:00pm*. Full-day programs during school breaks operate from 7:00am-6:00pm. Please see the program handbook for a listing of days and holidays when the program is closed.

*For Calabash: the before school program begins at 6:30am and the after school program ends at 6:30pm. This program location only accepts children in grades TK, K and 1st.

**AM Care Only provides the program on School Days Only. Program days during school breaks and non-school days requires a separate enrollment.

***During school breaks (fall, winter & spring break day camp), the YMCA programs fall under American Camp Association Accreditation. Locations may combine during school break care.
