A. Teacher Requests

How do we handle teacher requests from parents?. Emily Wagner provided some possible wording, Julie Lubibic (APEIS) brought wording from a nearby school. Gov. council decided to closely follow the wording of the request form of a nearby school to create a similar form to be given to parents who come to the office to make a teacher request. Essentially stating that classroom assignments are done by current grade level teachers and take into account a child's behavior, academics, instructional needs, social/emotional considerations, and balancing the classrooms.
