What is Dual Language Education?

La educación de lenguaje dual es..

- Un programa bilingüe aditivo que utiliza dos idiomas para la instrucción, el aprendizaje y la comunicación.
- Un programa de enriquecimiento con la expectativa de un alto rendimiento académico en dos idiomas.
- Un programa intercultural que reúne a estudiantes de familias que hablan español o inglés en casa.

Dual Language Education is...

- An additive bilingual program that uses two languages for instruction, learning, and communication.
- An enrichment program with the expectation of high academic performance in two languages.
- A cross-cultural program which brings together students from Spanish and English home language environments.
- Our Dual Language Program will have a 6th and 7th grade cohort for the 2024-25 school year.
- Nuestro programa de lenguaje dual tendrá un grupo de 6.º y 7.º grado para el año escolar 2024-25.
- Instruction will be 50% in English and 50% in Spanish..
- La instrucción será 50% en inglés y 50% en español.
- Students will have sustained instruction in Spanish for 3 years, beginning with 6th grade, and continuing through 7th and 8th grades.
- Los estudiantes tendrán instrucción sostenida en español durante 3 años, comenzando con el 6.º grado y continuando hasta el 7.º y 8.º grado.
- Bilingualism, biliteracy and sociocultural competence are the main goals of this program.


