3. SSC Business –
 - a. Principal Update – 10 minutes

1. Norm Day: k-2 are very full, essentially at capacity. We do have some room in 3rd. Did get 1 new teacher Mr. Han. Possible request for a 19th teacher. She would like to

eliminate one of the split classes, but we really need two more teachers to effectively do that for all the grades with splits. We will get about 88K back, still determining where those funds will go..maybe psychologist? To accommodate another teach we would need another class room. Could mean possibly taking away the YMCA room, since we are not required to provide them a space.

2. Acceleration Day: happening on October 19. Will most likely be similar to the teacher strike, as all teachers have notified they will not be coming. Aides will be on campus because they are a separate union. Pedersen will be sending out the pre-written statement from the District Soon with details of what's planned for the kids that day.

b. Committee Reports – 3 min each

1.1. Earthquake driller coming up. Announcement will go out. Looking to use the world P22 on campus to let teachers know there is an issue with a student on campus that would require students to stay in the classroom. Use of the phrase “Bobby unlock the parent center”, when there is a threat on campus, from outside the campus.
